HAUNTED HAPPENINGS

Collier playing possum for visitors

Better get your vocal cords in shape and prepare to scream. Collier Hall is the place to be on Halloween for a haunted house that crosses international boundaries.

Collier, the international studies dormitory, is putting on an International House of Horrors to-night and Saturday night. All of the regulars will be there: Frankenstein, Jack the Ripper and Dracula.

However, there are a few surprises in store. International ghouls like Japan's vampire and China's ghost will also be on hand to terrify visitors, said Dennis Shin, Collier resident assistant.

"I think it'll put some spice into the regular haunted house," he said.

Japan doesn't have a holiday like Halloween, said freshman and Collier resident Ann Kinmura. However, Japan can boast of its own witch, which Kinmura will portray at the haunted house.

The Japanese witch doesn't ride around on a broom or wear a black hat, Kinmura said. Japanese witches are formerly beautiful women seeking revenge for their murders. Kinmura said she'll wear a kimono, instead of the long black dress American witches wear.

Not all of the international students who live in Collier plan to play a character with international ties. Taizo Kawai, an exchange student from Japan, said he'll do his best to frighten visitors with a gruesome sight probably familiar to many haunted house goers.

"I will be a typical American dead possum," Kawai said.

About 35 Collier residents will don costumes, masks and



make-up to spook people who visit the International House of Horrors, Shin said. Residents can choose the characters they want to portray.

The zombies, witches and goblins at the haunted house will spook visitors in a variety of ways, Shin said. They'll do everything from grabbing people who walk by to chasing visitors through the hall.

"We're guaranteeing they'll be spooked," he said.

The International House of Horrors will have a very spooky atmosphere, Shin said. Collier is spending \$700 to rent strobe lights and a fog machine.

Shin said using Collier residents to spook visitors "adds intensity" to the haunted house experience.

Last year, Adams Hall put on a haunted house, which at-

tracted 550 people and raised \$450, said Shin, who was Adams' resident assistant last year. This year, Shin said Collier hopes to attract 1,000 people.

Adams' haunted house was "really a frightening thing," said Justin Delacour, Collier Hall president. But this year's house of horrors has a "different flair" because of the international versions of well-known monsters.

Some international students have never heard of Halloween, Delacour said.

"We're giving them an opportunity to see what the holiday is all about," Delacour said.

You can visit the International House of Horrors — if you dare — from 8 p.m. to midnight. Admission is \$1.
