Husky QB Hobert under investigation for \$50,000 loan

SEATTLE (AP) - University of Washington officials are investigating a newspaper report that Husky quarterback Billy Joe Hobert accepted \$50,000 in loans from an Idaho businessman last spring under conditions that could violate NCAA rules.

The loans, made by the father-in-law of one of Hobert's friends, have no payback schedule, though full payment can be demanded at any time, The Seattle Times reported in a copyright story to-

Hobert said he spent the \$50,000 in three months on cars, guns, stereo equipment, golf clubs and wild weekends.

"I have to say the money I borrowed wasn't the smartest thing I've done because I ended up blowing it and now I've got all these bills and nothing to show

for it," said Hobert, who led the No. 1ranked Huskies to a national co-championship last season.

The loans could violate an NCAA rule barring athletes from receiving benefits not available to other students, the Times reported.

The rule says "a student-athlete may not receive preferential treatment, benefits or services (e.g. loans on a deferred payback basis) for his or her athletics reputation or skill or payback potential as a future professional athlete.

Washington Athletic Director Barbara Hedges said she learned about the loan late Wednesday and would investigate. She said if she finds a potential NCAA violation, she will report it to the Pacific-10 Conference.
