Paper

Paper can be recycled at over 450 locations throughout campus. Be sure that it's sorted into the right bins (colored paper, white paper, newsprint, etc)! But most importantly, **THINK BEFORE YOU USE!** Do you really need a whole sheet for that note? Will 100 people really read that memo? What can **YOU** do to reduce paper waste?

Paper • Guidelines

White Paper

Letterhead • Typing Paper • Stationary • Index cards • Notebook paper • Copy machine paper • Pre-printed forms • Other non-slick, white paper • Any size paper scraps • White paper with colored lettering acceptable (no background color)

Colored Paper

Paper products similar to previous category, except with color • Preprinted forms with color • No neon colors • No Golden Rod* paper (*shades of dark orange through light orange) • White paper with any amount of color beyond lettering

Computer Paper

All continuous form computer paper • Includes white as well as barred computer paper of any color—green bar, blue bar, etc.

Newsprint & 100% Unbleached

Daily types newspapers. No inserts. Comics okay. Please call to arrange special pick up for the other types of newsprint, such as any glue-bound material.

Items NOT Accepted

Self-adhesives • "Post its" • Peel & Stick Labels • Tape • Any Plastic—envelope windows, etc. • Golden Rod • Food Related Products: napkins, cups, plates and paper towels • Carbon and Self Carbon Paper • Brown Paper Bags • Coated Paper • Neon and Red Colored Paper • Glossy Paper • Coupon Books • Fax Paper

Physical Plant Recycling Program

In charge of recycling the waste generated by University facilities. To arrange pickups or drop bins for your department, call 346-1529.
