deserves even more recognition.

"I have a statement to make right now," Brooks said. "Tommy Thompson should be an All-American. Anybody who's seen him play that doesn't think he's an All-American should have their head pounded into the sand."

Thompson's three field goals gives him 17 on the year, including 12 of his last 14 attempts. He had field goals of 47, 43 and 40 yards on Saturday and is eight shy of setting a new Oregon record for field goals made in a season.

With all these field goals, it's easy to forget what was possibly the most important part of the game: Thompson's 76-yard punt. That punt, which Oregon downed at the three-yard line, gave the Ducks momentum.

After stopping the Bears deep in their own territory, Oregon forced California to punt from its own end zone. The Ducks scored on the ensuing drive and never looked back.

The Autzen Stadium crowd even started a "Tommy, Tom-

my" chant a number of times throughout the game.

"Did you hear the crowd?" quarterback Danny O'Neil yelled to Harris after the game. "They were chanting, 'Tommy, Tommy.' He's only the kicker."

Harris got his share of chants from the crowd, too, after he caught a 56-yard touchdown pass in the third quarter to put the Ducks ahead 31-17. He added to that catch a total of 94 yards on four punt returns, and two of those returns set up Oregon's first two scores of the game.

Harris' first return of the game went for 19 yards to the California 29, and the Ducks scored a touchdown two plays later. The second was a brilliant 64-yard return to the Bears' six-yard line. Oregon scored on the following play when fullback Juan Shedrick plunged in on his only carry of the game.

On the punt return, Harris broke at least three tackles and looked to be flirting with the idea of a lateral, but he pulled the ball back in and was knocked out of bounds.


