are unsure what level they're at can come in and watch videos to help decide.

"Perfect Track" is a clinic for cross country skiing. Private lessons are \$38, and group lessons are \$17.

Mount Bachelor is located 22 miles southwest of Bend, on Century Drive off Highway 97. For the daily snow report, call 382-7888.

Mount Hood Meadows: This area, celebrating its 25th anniversary, is expected to open Friday at the latest, and features both night and day skiing. Day lift tickets are \$27, night passes (good from 4 to 10 p.m.) are \$13, and all-day tickets are \$32. There are also snowboard and cross country ski areas, in addition to the downhill runs. Downhill skis can be rented for \$16 a day, cross country skis go for \$13 a day and snowboards for \$25.

A beginner lesson package runs \$30 a day and includes ski rental, a lift ticket and a 90-minute group lesson. Mount Hood Meadows has four chairs and five surface tows. Season-opener specials, featuring reduced rates on everything, are available Dec. 5 and 6 and Dec. 12 and 13.

Mount Hood Meadows will be open 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sundays. It is located on the east side of Mount Hood, 10 miles east of Government Camp on Highway 35.

For a daily snow report, call 227-SNOW.

Timberline: Timberline is also ready for skiers and offers day and night skiing. Until Thanksgiving weekend, the area will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., but af-

ter, it will stay open until 10 p.m. Hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday through Tuesday

and 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday.

Lift tickets are \$24 for day and night, and \$23 for the

day. Monday and Tuesday specials feature a day pass (9 a.m. to 5 p.m.) for \$14. Night skiing alone is \$7 Wednesday and Thursday nights, and \$11 Friday and Saturday nights. Ski rentals are \$16 for the entire day.

Beginner lessons take place daily at 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. for \$25. That includes ski rental, a lift ticket and a 90-minute group lesson. Also offered at those times are group lessons for other skill levels at \$38.

Timberline is located 60 miles east of Portland, off Highway 26. For a daily snow report, call 222-2211.

Hoodoo Ski Area: This ski area offers a guarantee — ski for an hour in the morning, from 9 to 10, and if you don't like the surface, you can leave with no charge.

Hoodoo, which got 13 inches of snow Sunday night, is expected to open Nov. 21. A first-time skier special is \$30 and includes an all-day lift ticket, ski rentals and two 90-minute group lessons. Twice-daily lessons, including cross country and downhill, are offered at 10:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. for \$12. Hoodoo also has a four-week Saturday program during January and February.

Ski rentals (all new this year) are \$11 a day. Day lift tickets, good from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. or 1 to 10 p.m., are \$18. An all-day "marathon ticket" is \$22. Afternoon tickets, good from 1 to 4 p.m., are \$14. Night-skiing tickets, good from 4 to 10 p.m., are \$12. Hoodoo is open Tuesday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Thursday through Saturday from 4 to 10 p.m.

Hoodoo features three chair lifts. It is located between Salem and Bend on Highway 20 at the summit of Santiam Pass. For a daily snow report, call 292-LIFT.

Willamette Pass: This area, expected to open Nov. 18., is another one close enough to be frequented by University students.

Ski rentals are \$11 a day, lift tickets are \$20, and a five-day pass is \$90. Night skiing, from 12:30 to 9 p.m.,

is \$20. An all-day pass is \$35.

Lessons for beginners run \$12 for a 60-90-minute group session and are every day at 10 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Private lessons are \$20 for the first hour and \$10 for each additional hour.

Twenty kilometers of Nordic ski trails are available for cross country skiers. Passes are \$6 and ski rentals are \$7. A season pass is \$65.

Willamette Pass will be open Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. It is located 69 miles southeast of Eugene on Highway 58 at the Cascade Summit. For a daily snow report, call 345-7669.

Mount Ashland and Anthony Lakes ski areas may be less well known than the others, but they are worth checking out.

Mount Ashland, located 18 miles southwest of Ashland off Interstate 5, is expected to open Nov. 25. It will be open daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Thursday, Friday and Saturday until 10 p.m.

Day lift tickets are \$23 on weekends and holidays and \$15 during the week. Night skiing is \$10. Ski rentals are \$14 for the day. For a daily snow report, call 482-2754.

Anthony Lakes, between LaGrande and Baker City at the North Powder exit off Interstate 84, is expected to open Nov. 27. Lessons are offered throughout the day and range from \$14 to \$26. Anthony Lakes has a student rate of \$17 a day. Regular day rates are \$20. Rentals are \$14 for alpine skis, \$10 for cross country skis and \$16 for a snowboard.

It will be open Thursday through Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and seven days a week during holidays. For more information, call 963-4599.
