## No roses for 'Cats, thanks to OSU



over Oregon State and Washington State, and the Huskies may even have a shot at the national championship if they win in Pasadena.

And it's all the Beavers' fault. Arizona is 4-1-1 in the Pac-10, and Washington is 5-1. That extra column for the Wildcats is there thanks to Oregon State. In the third week of the season, the Beavers tied Arizona 14-14 in Corvallis.

No, the goalpost didn't come down. No, Oregon State didn't put out a videotape entitled, "We Own the State and are Equal with Half of Arizona," but the Beavers may have if they knew what the rest of the season would be like.

At the time of the tie, no one knew how good Arizona was.

Washington plays the Beavers this weekend in Seattle, and the Huskies should give the Beavers a great big thank you hug before they tear the overmatched team apart.

Instead, nothing changed. Washington will still be the team in the Rose Bowl if it can finish the season with wins



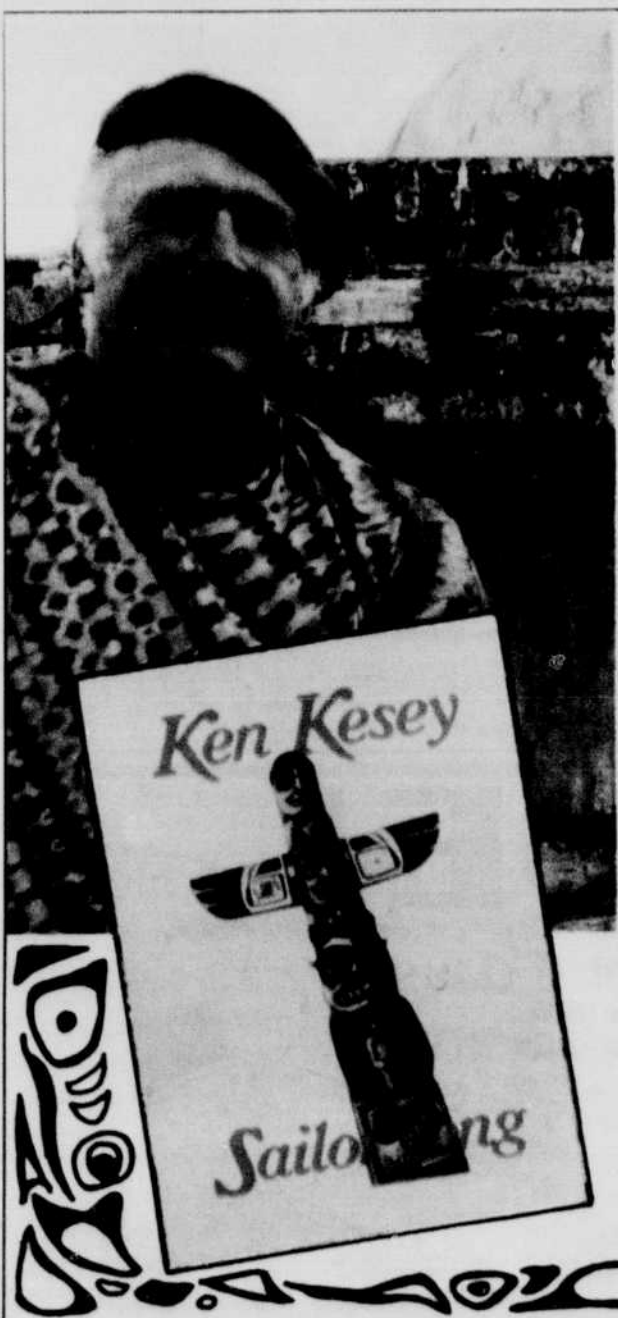
### You Can't Cram Your Way To An A...
