Van Borkulo-Goldstein struggled also struggled with illness at the Drenth Memorial and finished in a time of 18:11. She appears to be over the illness and ran a season-best 17:30 to finish eighth at Pac-10's.

"I'm glad we have had the two weeks off because we have not had all runners healthy at the same time yet," Heinonen

said. "Almost everyone has either had to take a day off or run only half a workout. Heidi is healthy, and Jenna is getting better, but I'm not sure. We need everyone ready by Saturday."
