Ducks try to salvage year against UA, ASU

The Oregon volleyball team will try to salvage the remains of a disappointing season as the team travels south this weekend for matches against arizona and Arizona State.

The Ducks, 2-12 and in last place in the Pacific-10 Conference, have yet to win on the road this year. Arizona, however, does have the dubious distinction of being the last team to lose to Oregon, having dropped the teams' previous meeting Oct. 17 at McArthur

Arizona State is in fourth place in the conference standings with an 8-6 record and is currently ranked No. 14 in the country. The Ducks nearly upset the Sun Devils in Oct., losing in five games.

Despite the disappointing record, several young players

have emerged as potential Pac-10 stars for the Ducks. Sophomore outside hitters Stephanie Warren and LaReina Woods have each had outstanding seasons, with Warren leading seventh in the conference with 3.96 kills per game and Woods third in the conference with her 3.74 digs per game average.

In the hunt for the conference title, UCLA appears to be a lock with its unblemished 15-0 record. The Bruins easily defeated No. 2 Stanford 3-0 last week for their final serious conference challenge.

Along with UCLA and Stanford, other Pac-10 conference schools still vying for a NCAA tournament spot include USC (11-4) and Washington State (7-7).
