Don't expect Oregon to watch oo many game films of UCLA this week, the Ducks spent all of last year watching them.

The 1992 UCLA and 1991 Oregon football teams are two very similar teams. Last year the Ducks were coming off of two straight years playing in a bowl game and were optimistic about a third year before injuries depleted their offensive backfield. Danny O'Neil was injured early in the year and the Ducks played five different quarterbacks before the year ended.

This season, the Bruins were coming off a 9-3 season capped off with a victory in the John Hancock Bowl and were looking at a possible game on New Year's Day. Tommy Maddox, their projected starter at quarterback, is now throwing passes for the Denver Broncos, and UCLA has had to play four quarterbacks this year.


