school proud and to make the Independence Bowl happy."

In 1989, 5,000 Oregon fans made the cross-country trip, and that fact had a lot to do with the Ducks receiving the invitation over teams like Rice, Southern Mississippi, Memphis State and Kansas.

"We picked them because we appreciated the fans they brought in 1989," John Lahmon, a member of the Independence

Bowl selection committee said. "We expect them to all come back this time and bring all their friends."

Brooks and his players all said their team's appearance in the 1989 game was more of a thrill than when the Ducks were invited to the Freedom Bowl the following year.

"The Freedom Bowl had Disneyland nearby," Brooks said, "but the functions we attended in Shreveport were much more enjoyable."

Senior linebacker Joe Farwell was one

of a handful of players who played in the 1989 game, and he said the players were treated like kings.

"You always hear about Southern hospitality," he said, "but you just don't realize what it's like until you've been there. They treated us like royalty last time we were there."

Brooks said there is no question in his mind that his team deserved the invitation.

"We're among the top one-third of the teams in the country," Brooks said. "We

may not be in the top 20, but we're not that far off. Our fans aren't happy at 6-5, and the team isn't happy at 6-5, but it just so happens that 6-5 and 4-4 in the toughest conference in the nation is good enough for postseason play, and I'm not about to apologize to anybody."

In accepting the invitation, Oregon also agreed to purchase 8,410 tickets at \$30 apiece and will receive \$650,000 in travel expenses.

The game will be at 9:45 a.m. PST and broadcast live nationally on ESPN.


