

People of color must educate each other, forum says

To end racism, people of color must educate themselves about each other and counteract the media's stereotyped images, about 30 students of color agreed at a forum on Asian-American and African-American relations.

LaVon Pierce Jr., an African-American, said he believes it's important for different races to become unified by learning more about each other.

Pierce said he once questioned an Asian roommate about his ideas of what African-Americans are like. His roommate asked him if it were true that all African-American men were pimps and drug dealers.

"Bojangles and big lips — these are the ideas he came to this country with," he said. "I didn't know stuff like this was played in this world, but that's what he

saw in the movies."

Gene Shaffer-Strathman, an African-American, said the "media jacks you up" in its portrayal of different races.

"I saw karate movies and thought if you see an Asian, don't mess with them because they will kick your ass," he said.

The way to bring the two communities together is to "work together," said Jan

Harada, a Japanese-American.

Enrique Gonzalez, a Chicano, said he sacrificed his culture during high school to fit in with white students and will "search out my identity my entire life."

The school system doesn't give students of color much of a chance to learn about their culture, Gonzalez said.
