Heiny said Oregon will be faced with a tough Brigham Young team that likes to run and play pressure defense.

"BYU is expected to win its league," he said. "They barely lost to a tough Montana team and beat Montana State. They play a full-court press and they like to run and get most of their points off the break.

Wednesday's game will be the first of three games in four nights for the women. They will face 24th-ranked DePaul

on Thursday and Weber State on Saturday.

Heiny is most wary of the game against the Blue Devils.

"DePaul should be the toughest game," he said. "They usually play pressure defense. They are quick and have good size.

The men, on the other hand, are coming off Saturday's crushing defeat against Pacific. The Ducks were 1-3 coming into the game against Pacific, but Oregon had a chance to win in all three of the previous loss-

That wasn't the case against the Tigers. Pacific led the whole way and ended up beating the Ducks 80-68 in a game that wasn't as close as the score indicated.

Men's head coach Jerry Green said he was disappointed with his team's level of play on Saturday, but is hopeful the team will be able to rebound.

'On Saturday, we took a step backward," he said. "We had played good at times in all of our previous games, but against Pacific, we didn't. I was totally surprised at how poorly we played."

Green said he did get some encouraging vibes about his 1-4 Ducks on their road trip.

"We proved that when we put it all together, we can be a very good basketball team," he said. "We played 20 good minutes against New Mexico State, 30 good minutes against Vanderbilt and 36 good minutes against Fresno State. We just need to play an entire game. I'm the coach, and it's my job to have the team ready to play, so I take full responsibility for those losses.


