of last season," Craig said. "There wasn't time to have surgery then, so I just had finish out the season with the injuries.

Amazingly, Craig said that several times during the season, Oregon coaches helped put his shoulder back into the socket during matches.

Despite the injuries, Craig finished 7-6-1 overall and captured second place in the Pac-10 meet, qualifying for the NCAA tournament. Craig looks to be the Ducks' best hope for a Pac-10 conference individual champion.

Oregon is coming off of a disappointing performance at the Las Vegas Invitational tournament, where the Duck's were only able to take 22nd place

out of 32 teams.

The best match on Saturday night should occur at 167 pounds, when Oregon's only nationally ranked wrestler, Mat Sprague, takes on third ranked Trent Flack. Other matches involving Duck wrestlers meeting nationally ranked wrestlers will include Jason Muggy against Ryan Sugal (6th) at 142 pounds and Clint Messner versus Dan Alar (10th) at 158 pounds.
