

# Heisman winner Torretta wants national championship

NEW YORK (AP) — Most college football players would be satisfied with one Heisman Trophy and two national championships. Not Gino Torretta.

After winning the Heisman on Saturday, the Miami quarterback set his sights on a third national title. Torretta can achieve his goal by leading the top-ranked Hurricanes over No. 2 Alabama in the Sugar Bowl on Jan. 1.

"I'm ready to go for the national championship," he said. "It would be a perfect way to end my college career."

Torretta started four games as a red-shirt freshman when Miami won the national championship in 1989, and guided the Hurricanes to another title last year. If Miami beats Alabama, he will become the first quarterback in 17 years to lead his team to consecutive national championships.

"My main goal was to leave Miami with more wins than any other quarter-

back, and I did that," said Torretta, whose 26-1 record as a starter is better than Vinny Testaverde, Steve Walsh, Craig Erickson, Bernie Kosar and Jim Kelly.

Testaverde, who won the Heisman in 1986, is the only other Miami player to win the coveted award. His backup during that season was Geoff Torretta, one of Gino's three older brothers.

"I was very happy when Vinny won, but obviously it means even more when your brother wins," said Geoff, who was at the Downtown Athletic Club for both announcements. "I can't think of anyone more deserving than Gino. They couldn't have made a better choice."

Some people disagree. They say Torretta won the Heisman not because he was the best player, but because he played on the best team.

"I don't buy that," Geoff said. "He's still the guy who touches the ball the

most and makes the most decisions. You can't have a great team without a great quarterback."

Torretta won by a comfortable margin over his closest challengers, running backs Marshall Faulk of San Diego State and Garrison Hearst of Georgia. Torretta, the most prolific passer in Miami history, got more first-place votes than Faulk and Hearst combined.

Faulk, the nation's leading rusher the past two years, was the Heisman favorite midway through the season. Injuries forced the sophomore to miss 2 games down the stretch, including San Diego State's season finale against Miami. Torretta passed for 310 yards and one touchdown as Faulk watched from the sideline.

"I think that really swayed the voters," Faulk said.

Faulk said he will remain at San Diego State next year. Hearst, a junior who led the nation in scoring and was second in rushing, said he hasn't decided whether to play another season at Georgia or turn pro. He will make up his mind after the Bulldogs play Ohio State in the Citrus Bowl on Jan. 1.

"After that game, I'll sit down and weigh all my options," Hearst said. "Right now, I'm really not sure what I'll do."
