Hemphill, an award winning author, poet, editor and cultural activist is a University artist-inresidence. Hemphill's writings come directly from his experiences as a gay black in America. Hemphill is known for his no-nonsense style of poetry, which is sometimes considered very graphic.

Berry, a scholar, author, attorney, historian and modern-day civil-rights activist, was one of the women chosen to be photographed by Brian Lanker, artist of "I Dream a World: Portraits of Black Women Who Changed America.

Berry has been involved in many civil- and human-rights struggles, including the release of African National Congress leader Nelson Mandela

Berry is one of the founders of the Free South Africa Movement and was jailed many times for her anti-apartheid activities.

Berry's address will be as keynote speaker for "The Dream Lives On Jubilee" at the Hult Center at 7:30 Monday. Berry will discuss the state of present and future civil- and human-rights strug-
