for lecture, is not too unusual in aikido, as those considered truly proficient have applied both the physical aspects and the philosophy to their daily life.

"My first teacher would say 'go home and make harmony first,'" said Chuck Hauk, an aikido club member.

Daryl Berlie, instructor for the aikido club, has de-

scribed aikido as "the study of vulnerability."

While studying this vulnerability, students would take turns as both Uke — the person being thrown — and Nage — the person throwing. Practicing with someone is an "agreement of trust," Berlie said.

"It is a learning process," said Phil Weiner, a visiting student from Arcata, Calif. "It's a way of life; it's very personal."
