**A**thletes are the most fortunate students at the University. Athletes are given the opportunity to play the sports they love against some of the stiffest competition in the country, and have the chance to possibly advance to the professional lev-

But is it the worst team in Oregon history? Believe it or not, the answer is no, according to former Duck Ken Strand. Strand said the title of the worst team in school history probably belongs to the 1971-72 squad, the first Oregon team since 1921 to go winless in conference play.

"We were the best-conditioned team in the conference, we
