
It's true! Ducks whip Huskies

No one would have blamed Jerry Green if he had ditched his crutches and jumped through the McArthur Court roof Thursday night.

But after the Oregon men's basketball team won its first Pacific-10 Conference game of season 85-70 over Washington. the Ducks' head coach played it off as simply a step in the right direction.

"It is one game," he said, "and one game doesn't make a season. We'll celebrate this one til midnight, and then we'll look toward Washington State Saturday

Oregon (1-11, 8-16) hit 31 of 34 free throws, and forward Aaron Johnson scored a career-high 19 points as the Ducks ended a 20game Pac-10 losing streak over two seasons.

'We don't want to blow it out of proportion, it's only a win.' Johnson said, "but we worked really hard for this one."

Oregon led at halftime 35-28, and built the lead to 41-30 to start the second half. After Orlando Williams hit a three-pointer, the Ducks led 44-32. Moments later, Husky 6-foot-11, 250-pound center Rich Manning picked up his fourth foul, and it looked as if Oregon would have smooth sailing the rest of the way.

But Washington refused to let the Ducks put the game away. Oregon led by 10 with 13 min-




