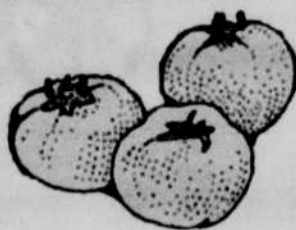
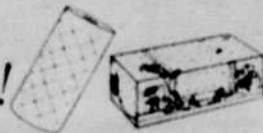

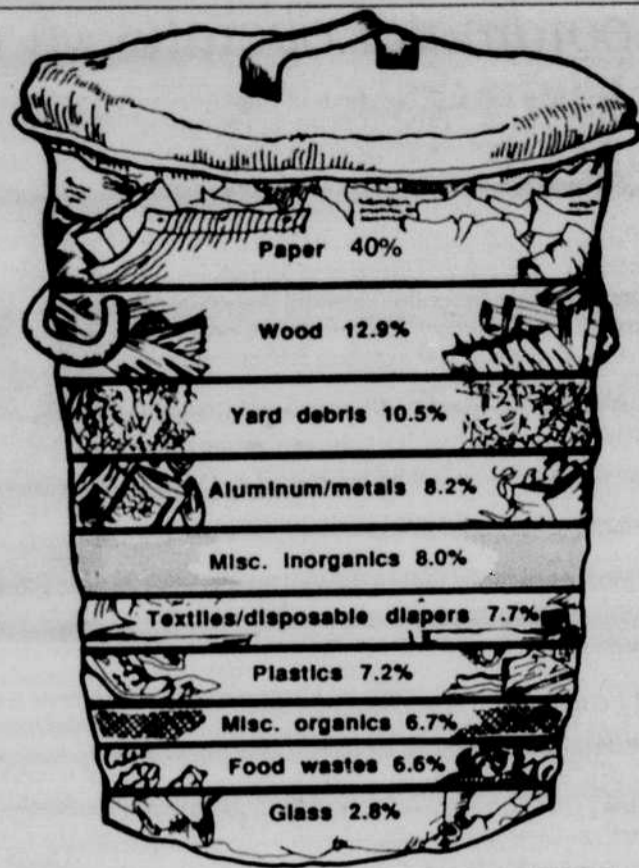

## What's in our garbage?

The "paper" category includes everything from newspaper, cardboard, office and computer paper to magazines, junk mail and packaging.

Sixty-two percent of the newspaper, 52 percent of the cardboard and only 20 percent of the office paper is recycled in the Portland area.

22 percent of the yard debris is composted.

• 35 percent of the glass is recycled.

## FACTS

- America used to have 6,000 landfills. We now have 3,000. By 1993 we will have 1,000 left.
- Each year Americans throw away 18 billion disposable diapers, 1.7 billion pens and two billion razors.
