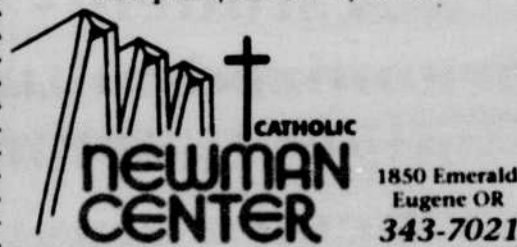

MSC

McKenzie Study Center doesn't fit the mold! From its beginning in 1979 MSC has specialized in helping students who wrestle with trying to

understand how biblical Christianity can possibly be relevant in post-modern society and culture. Most college students view religion-and Christianity in particular-as "anti-intellectual." MSC is a place where the role of serious thinking integrates fully with pursuing spiritual life. At MSC students feel genuinely free to air their doubts and questions without fear of being labeled "unspiritual."

With five full-time and three part-time staff, Faculty MSC is, in effect, a "mini-college." MSC is a non-denominational Christian organization that goes beyond the typical campus fellowship and outreach group to offer classes, tutorials, a live-in residence, as well as Christian counseling and academic guidance to students. MSC offers supplemental education to University of Oregon students wishing to have in-depth help in biblical studies-including offerings in the biblical languages of Greek and Hebrew-as well as classics, history of ideas, philosophy and the arts.

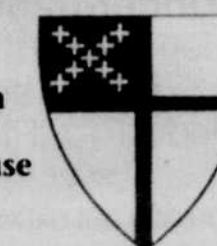
The university is a "marketplace of ideas." McKenzie Study Center is a place where students can get significant help learning how the Christian world view interacts with those ideas.
