Plane Tips

- · There are restrictions with any discounted ticket. Be sure you understand the restrictions before you buy your ticket.
- · Study your ticket carefully. If anything is unclear, ask for an explanation
- · When overseas, reconfirm your return flight at least three days before departure. The airline may cancel your reservation and reself your seat if you fail to do this
- · With increased airport security, you should check in at least two hours before departure for international flights.
