

#### Train Tips

- · When traveling long distances, get a seat reservation. For \$2-\$3 you can reserve a seat in first or second class, depending on the type of pass you purchased.
- Study your Eurail Traveler's Guide you will find that many boat, ferry and bus tickets are free or discounted
- · Study the timetables and become familiar with the 24-hour clock
- · Be prepared to meet people and make friends - a big advantage of train travel.

#### Automobiles

If you are traveling with a couple of friends, you might look into renting a car for a portion of your trip. It is almost always cheaper to arrange this



before you leave the United States. Council Travel can arrange a low-cost car rental for you anywhere in the world.

### Car Tips

- · Look into the cost of picking up your car in one place and dropping it off in another. This can be a real timesaver
- · Toll roads are not just a U.S. phenomenon; they are found throughout Europe and are very costly. Get off the beaten track and save moneyl
- · Purchase good road maps and study the signs for each country you will drive through. AAA has excellent information on overseas
- · Driving habits are different overseas. If you are a timid driver, travel by train!
