A missed jam can have the same results in the opposite direction.

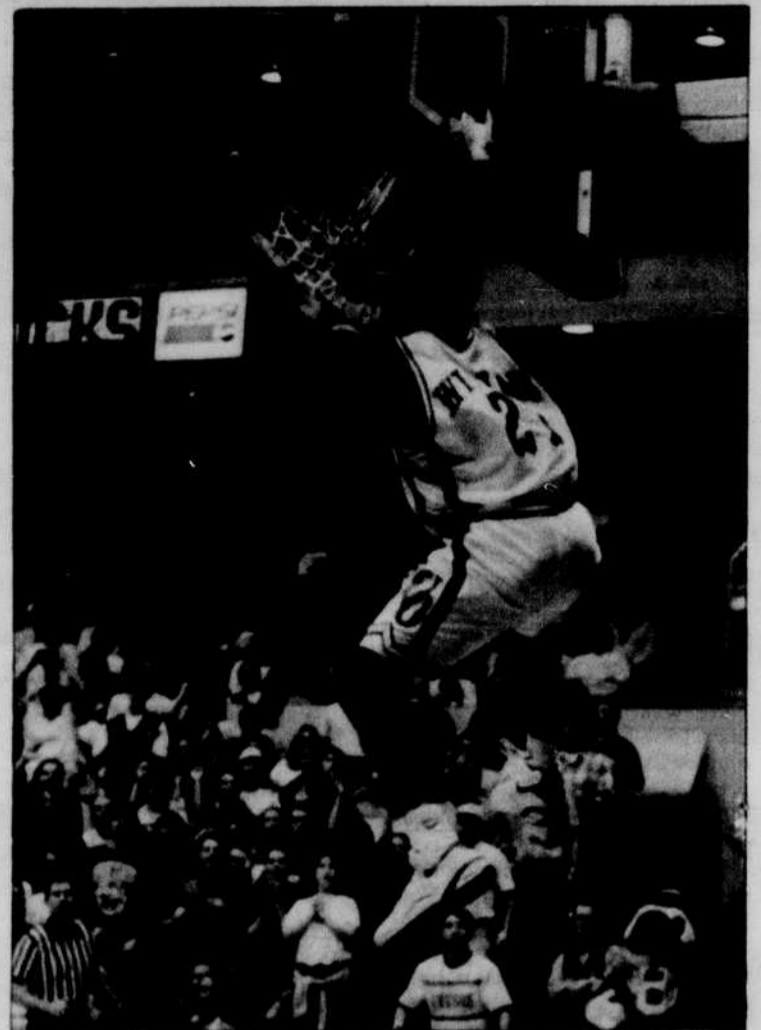
Just ask Scott Haskin, whose missed dunk at the horn actually lost the game for Oregon State in last season's Civil War game at McArthur Court.

Oregon's Orlando Williams returned the favor Saturday night when he missed an easy dunk midway through the first quarter.

The missed jam summed up the Civil War game between the two struggling Oregon schools.

The fans in attendance won't soon forget Oregon's two of 20 shooting in the first half, Oregon State's Brent Barry taking an open-handed swipe at a Duck fan in the front row, the Beavers' Charles McKinney trying to kick the referee after being called for a foul, or Jerry Green getting his first technical foul at Mac Court. It was simply an ugly game.

But Williams' miss is the one play that likely stands out in the minds of all who were in attendance.

When Williams stole the ball from J.D. Vetter, the Mac Court crowd rose to its feet in anticipation. Williams was all alone on a breakaway, and everyone knew he was going for the jam.

The 6-foot guard took off into the air, pumped the ball to the left and then threw the ball hard off the rim.
