Resident Director
Position Announcement
University Housing at the University of Oregon is now accepting applications for the position of Resident Director. This is a full-time, live-in, 12 month, faculty position with the rank of instructor. The starting date for the position is Aug. 1, 1993. The Resident Director is responsible for the overall administration of a residence hall complex consisting of approximately 700 residents. The Resident Director is also responsible for the selection, supervision and training of the residence life student staff and is expected to coordinate the conduct process, facilitate programming and work with the student government. The Resident Director reports to the Director of Residence Life. One available position is in the newly established International College Residence Hall, which is a pilot program for 93-94.

The remuneration for this position is \$18,000 cash, plus a one-bedroom apartment and full board during the time that the halls are open for food service. All regular faculty benefits such as health and retirement and reduced tuition are also included. A Bachelor's degree is required and a Master's degree in Student Personnel-related areas is strongly preferred. Group living experience is required, preferable beyond the level of Resident Assistant. Resident Directors may enroll for up to 6 units of credit per academic term, but are not expected or required to do so.

Staff representatives from Residence Life will be available at the NWACUHO and CACUHO conferences in April, to conduct preliminary interviews with candidates. Finalists will be interviewed on the UO campus between April 22 and May 7 and final decisions will be made approximately by May 17, 1993.

Applications and additional information are available at University Housing, Walton Complex, University of Oregon, Eugene 97403. Completed applications must be postmarked by April 5, 1993 and returned to University Housing, to be guaranteed consideration. Call (503) 346-4277 with questions.
