## Golf teams return to action down south

The Oregon men's and women's golf teams are traveling south this weekend to begin the homestretch of their spring schedules.

The men will have double duty as they compete in the Fresno State Individual from April 2-3 before playing in the Southwestern Intercollegiate in Westlake Village, Calif., April 5-6.

Senior Jeff Lyons and sophomore Ted Snively lead the Ducks after tying for 30th place in Oregon's last tournament by shooting 74 in both rounds.

The Oregon women return to

action after almost one month off when they play in the Lady Sun Devil Invitational in Tempe, Ariz. The women took second place in their last tournament, the Brigham Young Invitational March 8-9.

Shannon Maier, Christel Tomori and Leigh Casey all placed in the Top 10 in their last tournament, and they will compete for the Ducks again this weekend.

Karly Mills will play for the Ducks after tying for 19th in Utah, and Cappy Mack will round out the Oregon lineup.

## Ducks to face UW, WSU

The Oregon softball team will travel to Washington this weekend to face Washington and Puget Sound in doubleheaders Saturday and Sunday before returning for its home opener.

The Ducks are coming off a Spring Break road trip during which they went 6-7 and evened out their overall record at 11-11 and 3-3 in the Pacific-10 Conference. The Ducks opened the trip with a doubleheader split against California and sweeps against Stanford and St. Mary's before they lost six of their final seven games.

The Ducks were led on offense on the trip by freshman shortstop Kathy Stahl and junior catcher Laura Schmidt. Schmidt was named Pac-10 Player of the Week. After the Washington trip, the Ducks will return to play Portland State on April 9, which will be their first of six home doubleheaders in April.
