IFC chops budgets, eliminates position

At its Monday meeting, the Incidental Fee Committee approved an 11 percent budget increase for the Division of Education Policy and Management by a 5-0 vote.

However, DEPM, a support program for education administration graduate students, was the only student group to receive a budget increase Monday. The Pre-Health Science Center, a peer advising group for students interested in medicine, physical therapy or veterinary medicine, received the largest budget decrease from the IFC.

By a 5-0 vote, the committee eliminated the center's \$25-a-month director position, which decreased the center's budget by 35 percent. IFC members said they voted to remove the group's paid director

position because it only required 10 hours of work each week.
"I don't see it taking up as much time as other groups do;" IFC member Lydia Lerma said.

Other groups receiving budget decreases included Land, Air and Water and ESCAPE.

IFC committee members also approved a \$300 special request by the Black Student Union.

The BSU originally requested \$495 from the IFC to cover unexpected catering costs that stemmed from the BSU-sponsored Black History Month celebration.

BSU Director Leslie Warren told the IFC the cost overrun resulted from an inaccurate cost estimate provided to the BSU from EMU catering.

IFC member Efrem Mehtrab motioned to allocate \$300 to the BSU and suggested the group pay the remainder of its catering bill with money from its fund-raising fund.
