

# Two WSU football players injured

PULLMAN, Wash. (AP) — Two Washington State football players riding in a pickup truck were injured when an explosive device detonated in the vehicle, police said Tuesday.

Harvey Macy "Buddy" Waldron, 22, of Bellevue was in critical condition at Sacred Heart Medical Center in Spokane, and Payam Saadat, 20, of Santa Monica, Calif., was in satisfactory condition at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle, hospital officials said.

The nature of the explosive device and how it got into the truck weren't immediately clear, police said.

The truck hit a parked car after the device exploded Monday night, Sgt. Chris Tennant said in a news release.

Police and agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms searched the men's homes Tuesday morning. Material for making explosives was found at one of the residences, Tennant said.

Criminal charges may be pending, and there was no immediate indication that either man was asso-

ciated with any radical or activist groups, Tennant said.

Waldron, a linebacker, played in 12 games and was credited with six tackles. Saadat, also a linebacker, played in all of Washington State's junior varsity games the past three years.

Denis Ralser, is competing for playing time at split end.

Sophomores Cristin McLemore and Kory Murphy both saw limited playing time last year but showed their abilities when given the chance. McLemore averaged 17.8 yards on six catches, including a touchdown against UNLV. Murphy had only one catch, but it went for 20 yards and a near touchdown.

"Kory and Cristin have both played well this spring," Bellotti said. "Cristin played well in crucial situations last year, and Kory has improved dramatically in the last couple weeks."

Seniors Brian Brown and James Jessie have had limited playing time during their Oregon careers but are looking to gain experience in their final seasons. Jessie has only two catches in his two years at Oregon, both in 1991 when he started one game. Brown was Oregon's top punt returner last season before suffering a knee injury that ended his season.

Oregon's wild cards at receiver are Jamaal Wallace, a 5-foot-7, 165-pound recruit from Willamette High School in Eugene, and Jawanza Hadley, a freshman from David Douglas High School in Portland.
