scores during each round of the tournament.

Martin came on to lead the Ducks in the third round Tuesday, when he carded a 69 to tie for 19th place after heading into the final round. Lyons followed Martin with a 73, and sophomore Ted Snavelly shot 74 on the par 72 Sandpiper Golf Course.

Oregon entered the final round only two shots behind third place Oregon State, but faltered on the final day. The Ducks 382 total was the third

worst round of the day, and the Ducks were passed by California for fifth place. Oregon's 1,500 total strokes put them 17 shots behind UCLA, which moved up to third place on the final day.

Bensel finished the tournament with rounds of 80 and 77 to finish in 28th place, followed by Snavelly in 34th place at 304. Forster and junior Randy McCracken finished tied for 49th place at 313.

The finish was disappointing for the Ducks, who were coming off of consecutive team victories at the Western Intercollegiate and U.S. Intercollegiate earlier this month.

who can develop endurance but still have speed at the end, for an American male to win," Mills said. "It's a bit of a surprise that no American has won since 1964, but it's almost more a disappointment that American distance runners haven't progressed."

Mills was asked if he had any ties to the University.

"My history with Oregon was running behind the Ore-

gon runners," Mills said. "I never ran here, but I was well aware of the Oregon runners and the tremendous talent they had."

Mills was also asked if he had any memorable races with Oregon coach Bill Dellinger, who won a bronze medal at 5,000 meters in the same 1964 Tokyo Olympics in which Mills won his gold.

"No, but I really felt if he would have moved a bit quicker, he would have won the gold medal," Mills said, laughing.
