

# Seles released from hospital after stabbing

HAMBURG, Germany (AP) — Monica Seles, the top-ranked women's tennis player, was released from a hospital Sunday, two days after being stabbed in the back by a mentally deranged man.

A statement released by Seles' agent said she departed for the United States. Seles, 19, has lived in the United States since 1986 and lists her residence as Sarasota, Fla.

The statement did not say where she was flying.

The International Management Group, her agent, released statements given by Seles before her departure.

"I want to thank all the people here who

have helped me over these last few difficult days," she said. "The greetings and the best wishes I received from so many people are a great support to me and I want everyone to know how much it means to me and how much it has helped."

The statements said Seles was feeling better but would remain under medical supervision for an undetermined period of time.

Doctors said Saturday that it would take one to three months for her to recover from the stab wound, making it unlikely she would play in the French Open starting May 24, a Grand Slam tournament Seles has won three years in a row.

If Seles does not play in the French Open,

she could lose the No. 1 ranking to Steffi Graf. The man who stabbed Seles said he was a Graf fan who could not bear seeing Seles atop the world rankings.

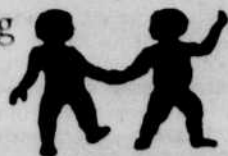
