

seconds off the qualifying time in the 800 meters, and Lisa Bedwell is only 0.3 away from qualifying in the 200.

Oregon will have several runners looking to qualify for the NCAA meet in the 5,000-meter run. Nicole Woodward, Jenna Carlson, Heidi Van Borkulo-Goldstein, Jill Callero and

Niamh Zwagerman are all entered in the race, which is expected to include Olympian Annette Peters and former NCAA champion Sylvia Mosqueda.

Erika Klein will get her best opportunity of the year to run a NCAA qualifier in the 1,500 because former Cal-State Northridge All-American Darcy Arreola and Olympian Suzy Hamilton will also be competing.


