Harris, Woods, Klein win awards

Multi-sport athletes Ronnie Harris, LaReina Woods and Erika Klein were the recipients of the athletic department's most prestigious awards at the annual Senior-Scholar Athlete Recognition Dessert, which took place Wednesday in the EMU Ball-

Harris, a wide receiver on the football team and a sprinter on the track team, won the Emerald Athletic Award for outstanding achievement in athletics, scholarship, and citizenship.

"Coming from a small school, I was just happy to make the football team." Harris said. "The award is just icing on the cake. I had a blast here at Oregon; I was just really fortunate to be able to play two sports."

Klein won the Jackson Award as the top senior woman athlete at the University. Klein, a political science major from Lynwood, Wash., was on the Pacific-10 Conference championship cross-country team and took second in the 1,500 meter run at the conference track championships.




