

Harris, Woods, Klein win awards

Multi-sport athletes Ronnie Harris, LaReina Woods and Erika Klein were the recipients of the athletic department's most prestigious awards at the annual Senior-Scholar Athlete Recognition Dessert, which took place Wednesday in the EMU Ballroom.

Harris, a wide receiver on the football team and a sprinter on the track team, won the Emerald Athletic Award for outstanding achievement in athletics, scholarship, and citizenship.

"Coming from a small school, I was just happy to make the

football team," Harris said. "The award is just icing on the cake. I had a blast here at Oregon; I was just really fortunate to be able to play two sports."

Klein won the Jackson Award as the top senior woman athlete at the University. Klein, a political science major from Lynwood, Wash., was on the Pacific-10 Conference championship cross-country team and took second in the 1,500 meter run at the conference track championships.

Woods won the Higdon Trophy, given annually to a top University sophomore for excellence in athletics, academics,

and citizenship. Woods was an outside hitter on the volleyball team and a sprinter on the track team. She tied the school record at 100 meters and led the 4x100 relay team to an upset victory over ASU at the conference championships last weekend.
