Jordan outscores Bulls, leads Chicago over Knicks

CHICAGO (AP) - It is the way champions play basketball; it is the way Michael Jordan plays basketball.

The Chicago Bulls, once down 2-0 in their playoff series with New York, beat the New York Knicks for the second straight time, a 105-95 victory Monday in a roaring Chicago Stadium, a game in which Jordan finished with 54 points and left his signature on why he is simply basketball's best player.

In a commanding display, Jordan

scored more than half of his team's points, shooting 18 of 31 from the field, including six three-pointers, after going only three of 18 in Saturday's 103-83 tri-

But for all of Jordan's theatrics, the Bulls did not secure game four until Scottie Pippen converted a three-point play with 2:09 left and Jordan followed with another basket with 1:36 remaining.

The Eastern Conference finals, tied 2-2, resume Wednesday night at New York's

Madison Square Garden, where the Knicks have won 27 straight. Game six will be in Chicago Friday night.

If a seventh game is needed, it will be in New York next Sunday.

It was the sixth time Jordan had scored 50 or more points in playoff games. He holds the all-time playoff high — 63 against Boston in double overtime in

The Knicks made a final bid with less

than three minutes to play when they came within 94-90 on a basket by Patrick Ewing and a free throw by Charles Oakley. Then Pippen put it away.

John Starks and Ewing each scored 24 points for New York. Horace Grant had 14 for Chicago and Pippen added 13.

This game, unlike the previous three, was a relatively tame affair. No punching, no head-butting - just a whole lot of Jor-
