# Slaney undergoes surgery; will miss championships

(AP) - Mary Slaney has undergone surgery on her left heel, ending her track season before it started.

Slaney, who hopes to be able to run some road races by the end of the summer, will miss the USA Mobil Outdoor Track and Field Championships, which will be June 15-19 at Hayward Field.

Slaney, 34, holds American records at 800, 1,500, 2,000 and 3,000 meters, as well as the mile. But her career, especially the past two years, has been plagued by injury.

Slaney said she decided to undergo surgery last week because she wants to be in good shape for her attempt to make the 1996 Olympic team. She intends to switch to the 10,000 meters for her Olympic effort.

'There's no doubt about the desire," Slaney said. "That's there. Along with all the frustrations, there's plenty of desire and frustration, and one of these days I'm going to get through it all at the right

Slaney said she has been bothered by pain since twisting her foot before a scheduled appearance in a road race in Carlsbad, Calif., in March. The pain had hampered her prepara-

tion for the national championships.

'It would feel better after resting it for a few days or a week, but it would get sore after I started running again," she said. "It got to the point where I would not be able to do the intensity of workouts that I need to do to race.

The operation was performed by Dr. Don Baxter, a Houston orthopedic surgeon who specializes in foot and ankle

Slaney said Baxter's examination showed she suffered from tendinitis and from a disorder of the bone around the heel. The surgery last Thursday went well, she said.

"Once it heals, it should be perfect," she said. "The tough thing is that I really wanted to have a good season. But I'll be

running, hopefully, within a month."

Slaney hopes to run road races in late August or early September but won't try to make any track appearances this year.


