Duck women still in hunt for national track title

Even though Oregon is sending 10 athletes to the NCAA track championships, its largest contingent since 1988, the Ducks probably don't have the depth to overtake pre-meet favorite Louisiana State, the winners of the NCAA title the past six years.

If the Ducks perform as expected, they should score between 20 and 30 team points this weekend. Even if the Ducks don't contend for the national title this weekend, they are nearly assured of their first top-10 performance since the team's third place finish in 1988.

Nicole Woodward took fourth in her 3,000 meter semifinal heat to qualify for Friday night's final.

The 4x100 relay team, consisting of Camara Jones, LaReina Woods, Lisa Bedwell, and Jamila Godfrey, failed to qualify for the final by placing third in its qualifying heat heat with a time of 45:18.

After two events in the heptathlon (100 meter hurdles and the high jump), Kelly Blair is in fourth place with 1938 points.

Today's Action

Blair competes in the final day of the heptathlon.

Events scheduled for today are the long jump, javelin, and 800 meter run.

Camara Jones will look to qualify for the 400 meter final as she runs in the semifinal heat at 5:10 pm. Jones is expected to have no trouble qualifying for the final as she entered the competition with the third fastest time in the nation.

Senior Erika Klein will look to conclude her outstanding career with an all-American certificate in the 1,500 meter run. To get to Saturday's final, Klein must first get out of the qualifying heats which begin at 6:15
