MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

A Craft Center membership entitles you to use the facilities and tools in the Craft Center for the term. Membership is always available to the entire UO community and UO alumni. The general public may purchase a Craft Center membership with enrollment in a Craft Center workshop costing \$15 or more. Day use passes are available for current UO students, faculty, staff and alumni. Memberships are valid for the term in which they are purchased and are not refundable. Workshops using the Craft Center facilities and equipment require a membership and are indicated in the class listings.

\$15 General public, with enrollment in Craft Center workshop of \$15 or more. (If you cancel a workshop, your general public membership will be refunded.)

REFUND POLICY

- Workshops are 100% refundable 96 hours (4 days) prior to the first class meeting, but non-refundable thereafter
- Workshops which do not meet the minimum enrollment will be cancelled on or before the first class meeting
- If the Craft Center cancels a workshop, fees will be fully refunded—your option to retain your UO membership
- UO memberships are non-refundable if you cancel a class, although community memberships will be refunded
- \$5 Specials are not refundable

REGISTRATION

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis until classes begin or are filled. Early registration is strongly recommended. Workshop registration can be done in person or by mail and must be accompanied with full payment. Members of the UO community purchasing memberships will be required to present University I.D.
