Specifically? They were well known for feeding everyone and keeping the peace at Woodstock, and on this day they were mostly there to babysit kids, take care of trippers, and to "be a good kennel service," Squirrel said.

Speaking of dogs, this crowd had lots of them, mostly puppies.

"How dare these kids bring these gorgeous animals here and

let them run amok?" said Martha, a 40-year-old tourer who gets by on the wise investments of her parents.

She told me the story of a beautiful golden retriever puppy, lost to her owner, with a bite mark in her neck. The next day I did see a small golden puppy running across the footbridge, and out of the 86,000 who came that weekend for the shows, I met her owner, who was still separated from her.
