Ducks blow lead, lose at Cal

Most Oregon fans thought things were as bad as they could get last New Year's Eve when the Ducks blew a 19-point lead on their way to a 39-35 loss to Wake Forest in the Independence Bowl.

It just got worse.

The Ducks (3-1) blew a 30-0 lead at California Saturday, losing to the Golden Bears 42-41 in **Oregon's Pacific-10 Conference** opener.

Oregon's mammoth collapse was the biggest in Pac-10 history and fell one point short of tying the NCAA record. Cal quarterback Dave Barr completed the comeback when he found receiver Iheanyl Uwaezucke for a 26yard scoring pass with 1:17 left in the game before Mike Caldwell caught a pass for the two-point conversion.

Things looked great for the Ducks during the opening 25 minutes of the game, as they cruised to a 30-0 lead. Oregon marched 94 yards on its first drive before quarterback Danny O'Neil found receiver Dameron Ricketts for a 22-yard touchdown.

California turned the ball over on its next two possessions and Oregon responded with touchdown passes from O'Neil to receiver Derrick Deadwiler and
