Oregon and Stanford ready for Saturday shoot-out

Ithough Stanford and Oregon are 1-2 in the conference in passing offense, they rank 10th and ninth in rushing, respectively. Stanford is the only Pac-10 team averaging less than 100 yards rushing (it averages 72.1) and they rank dead last in the nation in that

Ellery Roberts leads the Cardinal in rushing with 395 yards, an average of only 43.9 yards per game. No other Cardinal is averaging more than 20 yards per game rushing. This would appear to be good news for the Ducks, who gave up 389 yards rushing to Arizona last week, but Oregon has struggled to defend the pass as well this year.

We need to regroup coming off one of our worst defensive performances in recent memory," said Brooks, who can pass Len Casanova for the most wins in school history if he gets his 83rd win Saturday. "It was very discouraging to look at the tapes and see our lack of aggressiveness (at Arizona)."


"I felt we might have a defense that was acceptable and have a bright future," Walsh said. "We are disappointed in how we've done because you can't do much worse."


