## Ducks face OSU in season finale

Forget the intrastate rivalry. Motivation won't be a problem when Oregon and Oregon State meet in volleyball on Friday night.

A victory by Oregon would help end a long, unhappy season on a positive note and would be only the second win by the Ducks since mid-September. A win by Oregon State would bolster its outside chance of gaining a berth in the NCAA tournament.

For both the Ducks, 1-16 in the Pacific-10 Conference and 4-21 overall, and the Beavers, 7-10 in the Pac-10 and 15-12 overall, the prospect of one more win this season is more important than the opponent.

At least that's what the coaches say. "We want to get up for a match against our rival, and we know they do the same thing. But the fact that this is our last game and that it's been a frustrating year — we probably will be focusing on that

more than on the Beavers," Oregon head coach Gerry Gregory said.

"Other than them being our sister school, I think it's just two more teams playing one more Pac-10 match," Oregon State head coach Jeff Mozzochi said.


Friday's 7:05 p.m. contest at McArthur Court will be the final match for senior swing hitter Nicolle Hedberg. Hedberg missed most of the season with an ankle injury before seeing action last Saturday against Cal.

It's possible that the Oregon State match may also be Gregory's last as Oregon's coach. Gregory is completing his eighth season as Oregon's coach and has accumulated a 107-121 record.

Gregory has taken the Ducks to the NCAA tournament three times and is a member of the United States Volleyball Association Hall of Fame, but Oregon finished seventh in the Pac-10 in 1990, ninth in 1991 and 1992 and is assured of a 10th-place finish this season.

## Wrestler signs with UO

Royce Repenn, a three-time placer in the state of Washington, has signed a letter of intent with Oregon, the school announced Thursday.

Repenn, who is expected to compete at 167 or 177 pounds for the Ducks, has won the Washington and Northwest Regional Junior Freestyle Championships.

Currently in his senior season at Liberty High School in Renton, Wash., he has accumulated a 76-12-1 career record in his first three years. In addition to wrestling, Repenn carries a 3.66 GPA and was voted all-conference as a running back and linebacker in football.

"We are very excited about Royce's decision to attend Oregon," Oregon head coach Ron Finley said. "He has great athletic ability and, more importantly, a tremendous work ethic that will enable him to reach his full potential."
