Women lose their opener

The Oregon women's basketball team began its season Monday with a 66-54 exhibition loss to the Knox Raiders.

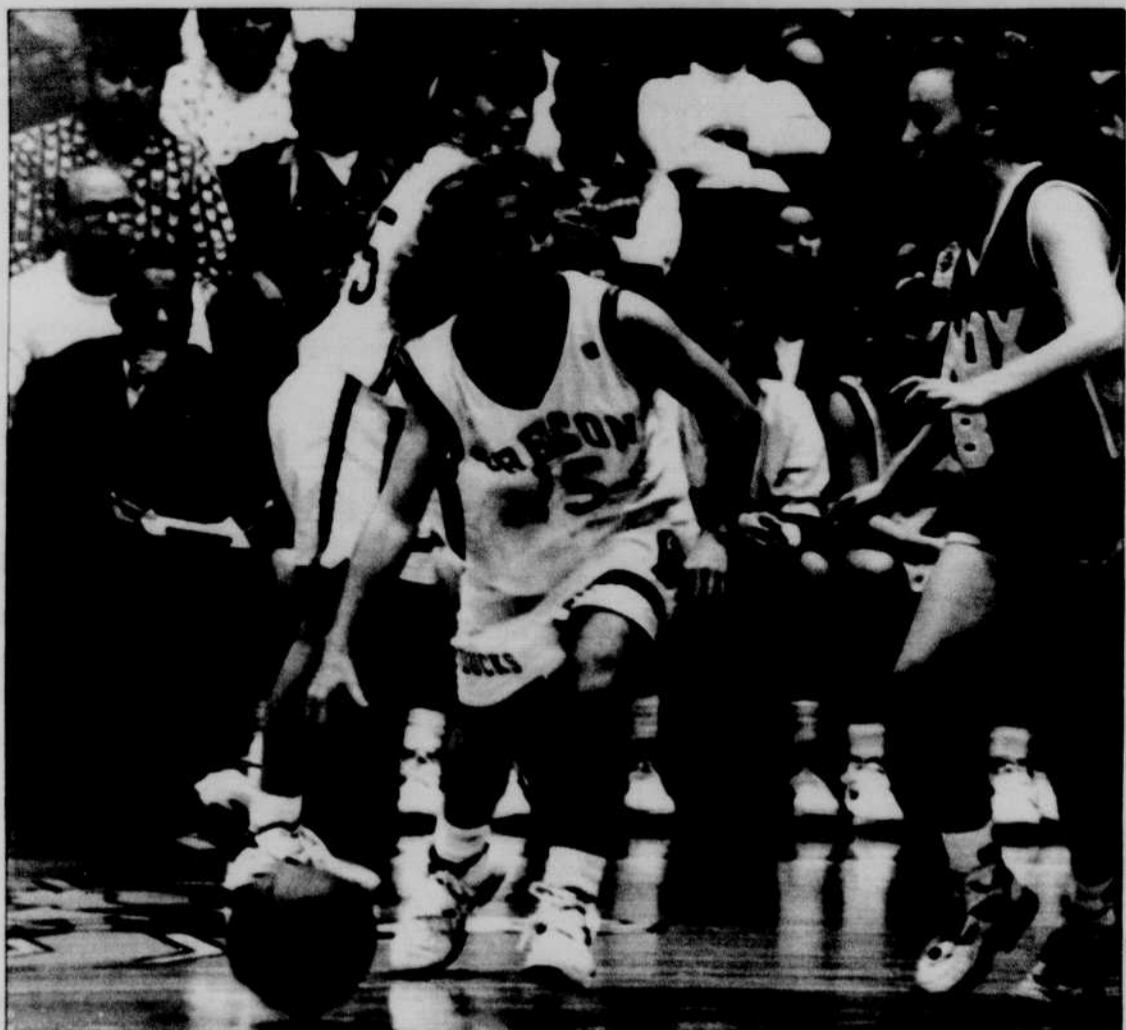
In their first game under new head coach Jody Runge, the Ducks trailed by one point at halftime before being outscored 34-23 in the second half by the Raiders, a team from Australia.

Oregon was nine of 26 from the field in the second half and shot .377 for the game, and Knox shot .475. The Ducks committed 25 turnovers and were outrebounded 37-31 in the loss.

Guard Missy Croshaw scored 13 points and dished out three assists for Oregon. Forwards Jessica Schutt and Debbie Sporcich each added eight points. Center Sara Wilson was Oregon's leading rebounder with eight.

Oregon travels to Hawaii for the Thanksgiving weekend to play a pair of games in the Paradise Classic. The Ducks play Hawaii Friday and play either Loyola Marymount or Northern Illinois on Saturday.

The Ducks next home game is Dec. 11 against Idaho State.

Ducks win titles at first meet

Rob Tanner took Most Outstanding Wrestler honors as Oregon's wrestling team began its season by winning five individual championships at the Southern Oregon Open in Ashland Saturday.

Tanner, a redshirt freshman from Tillamook, beat San Francisco State's Jorge Montero, 6-2, to win the title at 142 pounds. Tim Kitchen, another redshirt freshman, pinned teammate Pat Hirai to win at 134 pounds. Kevin Roberts, who is ranked No. 12 nationally at 118 pounds, won his class easily, posting a 17-6 victory over Southern Oregon State's Chad Thompson in the championship match. Mat Sprague (177 pounds) and Jeff McCoy (190 pounds) also beat wrestlers from the host school to win their respective classes.

Heavyweight Chris Anderson, also ranked No. 12, notched a runner-up finish for the Ducks to go along with three third-place finishes.
