# Citizens critical of LTD proposal

The proposed McDonald site for the new Eugene LTD Bus Station will eliminate downtown parking spaces already in demand, said Lane Community College students, staff and administration and downtown business owners at a public hearing Wednesday night.

At the hearing, which was called to illicit comments about the Draft Environmental Impact Statement prior to making a decision about changing the site, 25 of the 28 people who gave testimony expressed concerns about the availability of parking if the proposed 176 parking spaces near the McDonald Theater are eliminated by moving the Eugene Station to the McDonald site.

"Why do so many people in this city want to eliminate the most-used city parking lot?" asked Darryl Ram, owner of Darryl's Custom Framing and Portrait Studio, located near 10th and Willamette. He anticipates a 50 to 80 percent loss in sales if the parking lot is closed.

"I'll just be one more entrepreneur who took his chances on downtown Eugene and is rewarded with financial ruin," Ram said to applause from the 65-member audience.

Two alternative sites to the current LTD station are proposed in the DEIS — the McDonald Site, which would be the block sur-

rounded by 10th Ave., Olive St., 11th Ave. and Willamette St., and the IHOP site, which would be surrounded by High St., 8th Ave., E. Broadway and the off-ramp of Ferry St. Bridge.

Several students of the LCC downtown center testified that lack of easy, accessible parking would force them to reconsider continuing their education because of the difficulty in arranging work and class schedules around a bus schedule.

Residents and staff members of the Olive Plaza retirement center also expressed concerns about

parking availability for themselves and their visitors. If the LTD Board of Directors chooses the McDonald site for the new Eugene Station, it will not only limit parking spaces near the center, but increase the level of exhaust and noise in the area.

"Please consider letting the Olive Plaza residents know how you're going to handle air pollution, the noise and the safety issues," said Margie Smith, President of the Olive Plaza Board, to the board of directors. "They are very concerned and they feel you have not been listening."
