## Halftime lead crumbles as Ducks bow to Cougars

Judging by Oregon's past two games, the Ducks have the first half mastered.

The question is, just how big of a lead do they need at halftime to be safe?

Saturday against Oregon State a 16 point halftime lead was more than ample.

Thursday night against Washington State, the Cougars quickly erased a seven-

point halftime deficit and rolled over Oregon 95-85 at McArthur Court.

We were getting after it in the first half," Oregon point guard Kenya Wilkins said. "Then, we came out in the second half like we had already won the game. We did the same thing at the end of the Oregon State game. We started watching basketball instead of playing basketball.

And the Ducks (1-3 in the Pac-10, 5-8

overall) watched quite a performance as Washington State guard Tony Harris and forward Fred Ferguson went inside and out on Oregon, combining for 32 of the Cougars' 50 second half points.

Oregon also watched Washington State hit four three-pointers in the first three minutes of the second half to cut the Ducks' 52-45 halftime lead to 60-59.

After Oregon built the lead back up to
