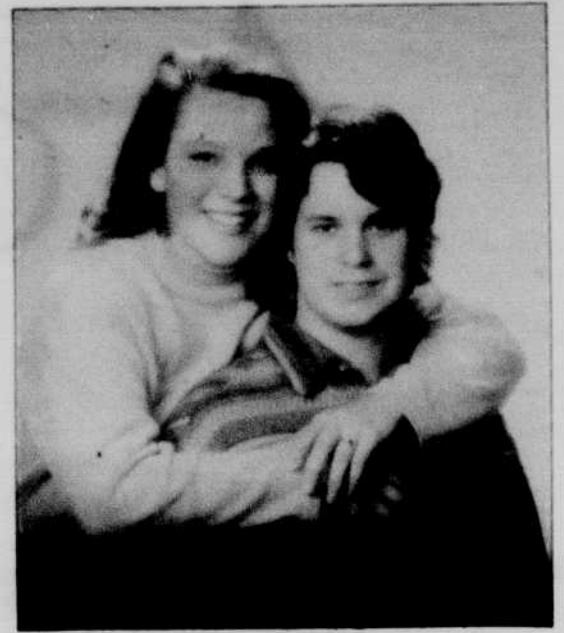
ners just to see the big moment.
