Patrick Gamman and Darrell Harris were suffering from last-minute jitters as they waited to have their nipples pierced, but it was too late to turn back.

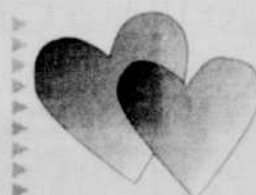
It hurt.

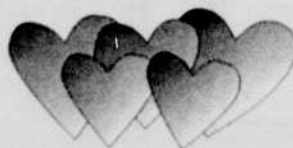
