

For Oregon hoops, a rare pair of sweeps

'O' hits for 40 points; Ducks shock Wazzu

Orlando Williams went wild Saturday, scoring 40 points and leading the Oregon men's basketball team to a 98-87 upset win over Washington State in Pullman, Wash.

Williams, who is averaging 32 points in the Ducks' last three games, hit 12 of 18 shots from the field, including seven of nine three-pointers. He also sank nine of 10 free throws to finish with the fourth-highest single-game point total in Oregon history. In addition, Williams tied the school record for most three-pointers in a game.

"The only thing he didn't

do today was sell popcorn," Oregon head coach Jerry Green said.

The win put the Ducks at 4-8 in the Pacific-10 Conference, 8-13 overall and came two days after Oregon broke a 27-game Pac-10 road losing streak with an 86-71 win over Washington on Thursday night.

Saturday, the Cougars were without the services of forward Mark Hendrickson and guard Dominick Ellison, but they probably would have been little help against an Oregon team that shot a season-high 65.3 percent from the field.

Washington State, which

Streak: Defense keys fourth straight victory for women's basketball

The paint job in the key says "The Pit." It might as well say "The Bermuda Triangle."

Week after week, opponents of the Oregon women's basketball team bring talented post players into McArthur Court and watch them disappear against the Duck defense. Two-time All-American Lisa Leslie of USC was held to 10 points. Pre-season All-American Tanja Kostic of Oregon State scored eight. Arizona's Kim Conway and Bonnie Dove combined for just six.

Saturday night, it was Camille Thompson's turn. The Washington State center entered the game as the Pacific-10 Conference's fourth-best scorer, averaging 20.1 points per game. Thompson scored only eight points against the Ducks, the Cougars shot only 34 percent from the field, and Oregon won 80-62 Saturday night.

The victory improved Oregon's record to 9-3 in the Pacific-10 Conference and 15-6 overall. The Ducks are tied with Stanford for second place in the conference, two games behind first-place USC.

Washington State, 2-11 and 7-15, needed a big game from Thompson in order to challenge the Ducks, but Thompson never got on track. She made only two of 10 field-goal attempts and fouled out with 6:29 left in the game.

Thompson saw the same defense that Leslie and others struggled against. Oregon's zone defense uses one defender, usu-
