kicks that punctuate the song's insistent rhythm.

Even though several of her songs wouldn't be out of place on a dance floor, she manages to explore some fairly serious topics, including love, freedom and racial harmony, this is true in "Djan Djan (Sound of a Rhythm)," in which she sings: "We may be black or white / but our blood is red / Why promote hatred and take it to the extreme / of selling your children... Who wants to listen to the cries of children? Their pain is red, like our blood. / I hear their cries, it shatters my heart."

Kidjo sings in Fon, her native language, although she sings two songs on Aye, in Yoruba, the Nigerian language. Like Keita's music, her songs are enjoyable without reading the translations provided since the arrangements and the musicians who play them form a tight ensemble, creating consistent music.

These two musicians, despite similarities in background, are excellent examples of the diversity in African music.

VAUXHALL AND I

Six years after the release of his first solo album, *Viva Hate*, Morrissey has just put out one of his best solo efforts to date titled *Vauxhall and I*.

If you liked *Your Arsenal*, you will love this album. The same style was used with this album, and it really works. The songs are heavily guitar-based, both electric and acoustic, and the lyrics are typical Morrissey.

All 11 songs on this album are worth listening to, and not one is boring. Each song grabs you somehow and holds you in its grip until the next song comes on. This is definitely an album that will wear out the repeat button on your compact disc player.

MELLOW GOLD

One word describes this record "FUNKY"! *Mellow Gold*, the debut album for Beck is the funkiest
