

# Snavely's victory paces Duck golf to fifth place

The Oregon men's golf team was unable to defend its team title at the Western Intercollegiate Golf Tournament, but junior Ted Snavely made sure the individual title stayed with the Ducks.

Snavely shot a final round of 71 Tuesday to finish the three-round, two-day tournament at 210, two shots better than Oregon State's Charles Kingsbaker and Kansas' John Hess.

One year after winning the team title at the tournament in Santa Cruz, Calif., the Ducks finished fifth with a team total of 883, only six shots behind tournament champion San Jose State.

The Ducks were up-and-down in the tournament, opening slow before coming on strong in the second round, only to fade back again in the final round.

Snavely was the only Duck to break 76 during the first round of the tournament, in which each team counts its best four out of six individual scores. Snavely opened the tournament with a 1-under-par 70 Monday morning to pace the Ducks to an opening-round 303.

The Ducks came right back in the afternoon round with a 283, their best round of the year, in which Snavely, Paul Regali and Randy McCracken all shot under par, with Snavely's 69 coming in one shot ahead of Regali and McCracken's 70s.

However, every Oregon player shot worse in the final round than they did in the second round, and the Ducks were forced to settle for fifth place.

Snavely's win was his first ever in college and culminates a recent hot streak that has seen him finish in the Top 10 at four of the Ducks' last five tournaments. The junior from Portland finished second two weeks ago at the Southwestern Intercollegiate.

Snavely opened the tournament two shots behind Joe Acosta of Fresno State, who shot 68 in the first round, but he took the lead for good with his second-round 69. Snavely entered Tuesday's final round with a three-shot lead over Kingsbaker and

Fresno State's Jon Bettencourt before winning the tournament with a 71 Tuesday.

McCracken came back from an opening-round 78 to finish with rounds of 70-73, good enough for a 15th place tie. Regali sandwiched his second round 70 with rounds of 76 to finish one shot behind McCracken and tied for 18th place.

Andy Scheidt was the fourth Duck to have his scores count toward the team total and finished tied for 50th place at 230. Freshman J.J. Astorquia and senior Jeremy Forster shot 249 and 251, respectively.

The Ducks now travel to Tempe, Ariz. for the Thunderbird Invitational beginning Thursday.

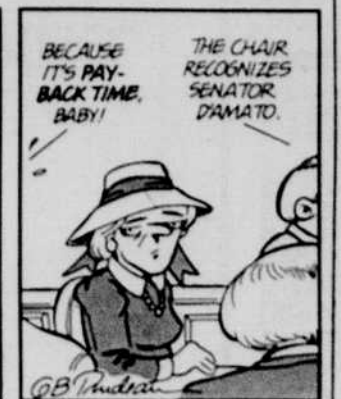
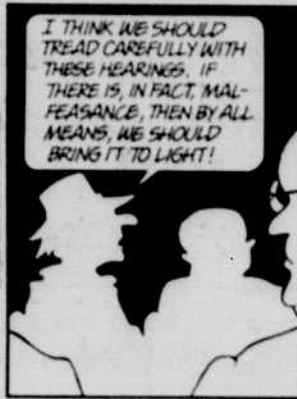
