It is responsible for making general policy decisions and long-range plans for all aspects of the operation of the Erb Memorial Union (EMU). The Board is responsible for allocating a \$3.7 million budget to programs and service areas and for allocating space in the 200,000 square-foot facility. The Board, of which students comprise the majority, also advises staff in the management and administration of the EMU.
