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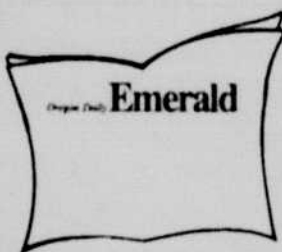
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Oregon golfer honored by Pacific-10 coaches

Oregon senior golfer Cappy Mack was an honorable mention all-Pacific-10 Conference selection in a vote of conference coaches.

The senior from Portland is only the third Oregon player to be named to the all-conference team in the program's seven-year history. Last season Leigh Casey and Shannon Maier also received honorable mention honors.

Mack, who transferred to Oregon from Notre Dame after her sophomore year, tied for 22nd place at the Pacific-10 Conference championships last week, helping the 14th-ranked Ducks finish fifth at the tournament. Mack tied for 14th place at March's Utah-Dixie Classic in

St. George, Utah and tied for 16th place at November's Pioneer-Electrics Bruin Golf Classic.

Mack had another tie for 16th place — this time at October's Ihanfeldt Invitational in Redmond, Wash. — and also won the individual title at the Oregon State Nike Invitational in Corvallis.

No. 1 Arizona State dominated the all-conference selections, placing four players on the first team, and head coach Linda Vollstedt was named Coach of the Year. The Sun Devils' Heather Bowie, Tracy Cone, Emilee Klein and Wendy Ward joined USC's Jennifer Biehn and Arizona's Lita Lindley on the first team.

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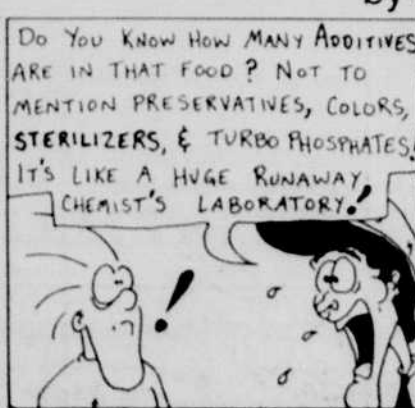
